Minutes for Board of Alderman Meeting - July 13, 2021

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Grus at 7:00PM.

Pledge of allegiance recited.

June 2021 Minutes were approved with typographical changes. Motion by Alderman Kuhrts, second by Alderman Griffith.

Old business was discussed. Mayor Grus reminded board of Bond Meeting on July 27, 2021 at 6:00PM. City Clerk position was discussed. It is still being advertised, City Hall will still be under limited hours, and the Mayor to handle bills/payroll.

New business was discussed. Mayor to be the authorized representative for DNR matters. This was made a resolution and approved by all board members present after a motion from Alderman Haase and a second from Alderman Bauer.

The Collector's report was reviewed. A motion was made by Alderman Griffith and seconded by Alderman Haase to approve the report.

Approval was given to pay the bills and accept the financial report after a motion by Alderman Kuhrts and a second from Alderman Griffith.

The Chief of Police's report was reviewed. A motion was made by Alderman Bauer and seconded by Alderman Kuhrts to approve the report. Sheriff Eiler requested access to the Rosebud Police Department for County deputies to utilize when in the Rosebud area. A motion was made by Kelly Kuhrts seconded by Doug Bauer and approved.

The Street Commissioner's Report was reviewed. Progress is being made on the Old Motel Road project. It should be transferred to the City of Rosebud by October. Bink Paving will begin working on streets at the end of August.

The Water and Sewer Commissioner's Report was reviewed. Parts came in for the new hydrant. Installation will begin soon and help will be called in for it. Clyde Zelch paid for the hydrant himself. The Board thanked him.

Both the Street Commissioner's Report and Water and Sewer Commissioner's Report were approved after a motion by Alderman Griffith and a second by Alderman Haase.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Alderman Kuhrts and a second by Alderman Haase at 7:10PM.

Immediately following the meeting, a Bond Election Information Forum was held. Several citizens were allowed to ask questions and staff from Bartlett and West along with the Board and Mayor answered their questions and provided facts on the upcoming Sewer/Water Improvement Bond which will be on
