Meeting called to order at 7:00pm by Mayor Grus, followed by the Pledge of Allegence.

The October Minutes were approved by Alderman Haase and seconded by Alderman Bauer.

Mayor Grus went over the Bartlett and West report for the month. Kyle from Bartlett and West is working on additional grants to cover more of the sewer project and possible water tower repairs.

New Business- Online water payments were discussed to stop the Court Money Process and start a Venmo account for the City. DNR primacy fee rates were discussed, new fee takes effect 01/01/2022. Chief of Police went over ATV & UTV ordinance. City Attorney will finalize ordinance and Chief will order stickers.

The Collector's Report was approved by Alderman Haase and seconded by Alderman Kuhrts.

The Financial Report was approved and approval was given to pay the bills by Alderman Bauer and seconded by Alderman Haase.

Chief of Police Report- Treasure Day officers did well and we may use them again. Still have increase in calls for service and reports taken. Halloween went well, over 80 kids showed up. Red Ribbon week went well at the Lutheran School. A flue fire occurred and rendered a residence unsafe. The Chief referred it to the City Attorney. It is currently in the process of being condemned. Bathroom at Police station has been renovated. Motion was made to approve the report by Alderman Bauer seconded by Alderman Haase.

Public Work Director Report- In regards to streets, some patching has been done on the side streets. In regards to water and sewer, there is only about 1000 feet of line needing to be jetted for the whole system to have been cleaned out. The Jetter needed repairs and it is running good again since. Water meters are getting hard to acquire, Core & Main, where we buy water meters from, now has a 52 week wait on new meters. Motion was made to approve report by Alderman Haase seconded by Alderman Bauer.

Clyde Zelch was present and said he has not run flow testing on the new waterline. He also shared he has been reading up on adding height to water towers.

Chief will be looking into ordinances and give info to City Attorney about trailers, boats and campers parked on the side of the streets.
